If you're in Nashville on a Wednesday night, don't miss this!

Gene heard a rumor that local musicians playing at the Music City Bar & Grill (www.MusicCityBar.com) performed his music every Wednesday night, calling it "Watson Wednesday"! Gene shocked the band and all the patrons of the venue when he casually strolled in on a Wednesday night in October. The band, delighted of course, put on a stellar performance of his greatest hits and Gene promised to return and join them on a few songs one day soon. Gene noted, "This is a terrific band and I'm flattered beyond words that they'd dedicate a night each week to my music. If you're coming to Nashville, be sure to check them out for some real country music."

Jody Miller was discovered by actor, Dale Robertson, and released her first album on Capitol Records in 1964. Her signature hit, "Queen of the House" won her a Grammy. She was later signed by producer, Billy Sherrill, to Epic Records in 1970 and charted two immediate hits, "Look At Mine" and "If You Think I Love You Now."



In 1984, Gene recorded the great Johnny Russell's song "Got No Reason Now For Goin' Home" for his album "Heartaches, Love and Stuff" and the song hit #7 on the Billboard chart . According to Gene, Johnny was not at the recording session for this song but they probably met up at a later session just to visit.



Gene can't recall the exact year this photo was taken for Capitol Records but believes it was around 1978. Back in those days, the label often used a Hollywood photographer. According to Gene, sideburns are making a comeback.
