Taping of a Larry's Country Diner Show on July 10th



Gene and Crystal Gayle are longtime friends as Gene toured in his early days with Crystal's sister, Loretta Lynn and Crystal sang backup for Loretta before becoming a solo star with 18 #1 hits of her own. Crystal has just released her first album in 16 years titled You Don't Know Me, a collection of country standards.



Dirk (piano) & Gail Johnson (fiddle) performed with Gene on the Larry's Country Diner taping in July. Dirk is Gene's producer and you will also see him playing piano on the Country's Family Reunion shows on RFD-TV.



Singer/Songwriter, Melba Montgomery, surprised Gene with a backstage visit. Melba had success as a solo artist with her #1 song "No Charge" and as a songwriter but she's possibly best known for her duet work with George Jones and the song she wrote, "We Must Have Been Out of Our Minds," which spent over thirty weeks on the Billboard Country chart, and peaked at No. 3 in 1963.



Gene was flattered by a visit backstage from two of Nashville's greatest songwriters, Bobby Tomerlin and Erin Enderlin. Bobby started his career in the music business as a DJ at the age of 11 and remembers his interview with Gene Watson. As a distinguished songwriter, Bobby wrote the #1 hit for Diamond Rio "One More Day" and his songs have been recorded by Barbara Streisand, Willie Nelson, Kenny Rogers, The Oak Ridge Boys and many more. Bobby has a new CD out titled "Out of Road." Erin Enderlin's songs have been recorded by Luke Bryan, Alan Jackson, Lee Ann Womack, Randy Travis, and Terri Clark. Backstage at the Grand Ole Opry: Whisperin' Bill Anderson and Gene are longtime friends. Bill has been a member of the Opry since 1961. He has released more than 40 studio albums and has reached # 1 on the country charts seven times. He's also considered the most prolific songwriter in Country Music history. No doubt Gene was whispering to Bill to get him some new songs to record.



Gene appreciates his longtime fans and these two ladies can prove they've enjoyed Gene's music for many years.


