

Graham Brown, dropped by to hear them sing the song he wrote on the album, "This Wanting You." After the show, Rhonda and Gene signed CDs (and skillets!) at the Ernest Tubb Store til the last fan left. It was by everyone's account, a wonderful night of REAL country music!

## FAN SPOTLIGHT ON SALLY BEDOW

Where do you live? I was born in Texarkana, Texas, lived in Hooks, Texas, married in 1964 and moved to Owatonna, MN, (where I am absolutely certain I was the ONLY country music fan in the entire state at the time!) and lived there until 2001. In 2001 my retired husband and I moved to Port Lavaca, TX on the Texas Gulf Coast between Houston and Corpus Christi. We are in the design phase for our "last" home to be built in Hooks with the plan of moving "home" in 2012.

What type work do you do? I work fulltime as the Contract Officer/Bookkeeper for the Port of Victoria, Victoria County, Texas.

Tell us about your family: My husband, Charles, and I have been married 47 years. We have a daughter, Jill, a son, Jack, and one granddaughter, Amanda. Lucky for me, our children and our granddaughter are HUGE country music fans....Charles, not so much....But we out number him!

Favorite GW songs? People often ask me what I think is the best country song ever recorded and that's easy: "Farewell Party" and certainly Gene's recording is the one against which all others are measured and none have equaled. But it surprises them when they assume that's my favorite Gene Watson song and I say "no". I made a list of my favorites but it had 17 songs on it. I finally narrowed it to these: my current favorite: "I Know An Ending", followed by: "Where Love Begins", "No One Will Ever Know", "Back In The Fire", and "She Found The Key".

Hobbies & Interests: It's really more of a passion and second career than a hobby! We breed, train, and show American Eskimo dogs and have for over 25 years. We have bred and/or owned over 150 UKC/AKC titled American Eskimos. We maintain a Yahoo Group for our dog owners and have an average of 100 participants. The main purpose of the group is for our dog owners to have 24/7 access to help if they need it: support in difficult times, and shared laughter in the fun times. 

When did I first hear about GW? I really don't remember. No doubt the fact that Gene is from the same part of Texas that I am and we are close in age probably made me feel more connected to him than perhaps other artists, but it does seem as if he's always been a part of my love of country music as an adult. Our children used to fight over Gene's cassettes back in the day. When we took our daughter to college in Duluth back in 1985 and started home I realized she had taken all of Gene's cassettes with her so we turned around and went back and "repo'd" them which did not make for a very happy new co-ed at UM-D.

What concerts have I attended? The 60's gig at a Houston dance spot might not necessarily be called a concert but that's the first time I remember seeing Gene on a visit with some of my cousins who lived in North Houston. Gene was in Florida once in the 80's when our family was there on vacation and we went to see him. I didn't see him again until this past February at the Stagecoach Ballroom in Ft Worth. On October 14th I have tickets to the Lovelady, TX event and I am looking forward to that.
