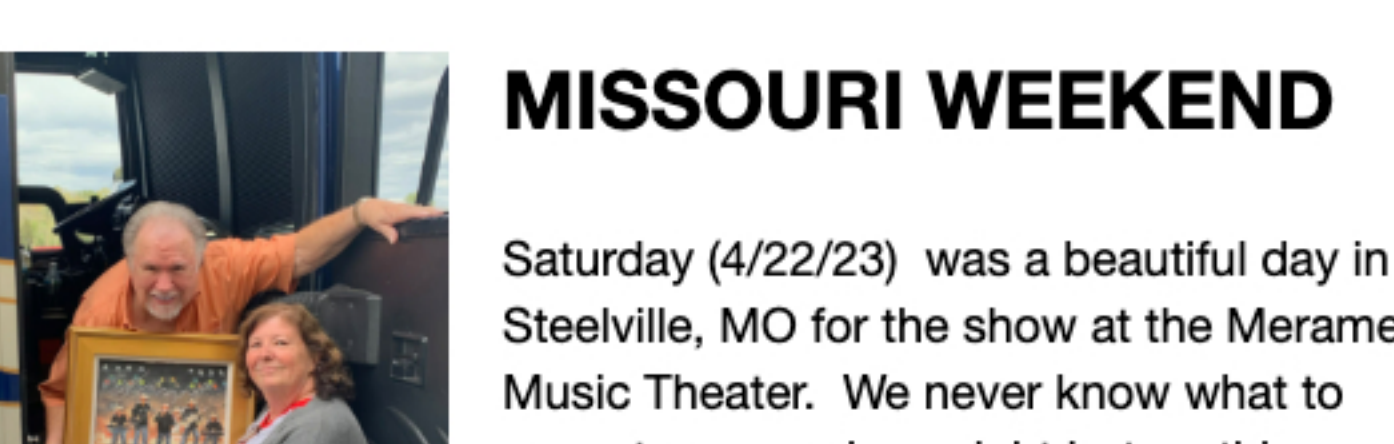
Hi Friends -

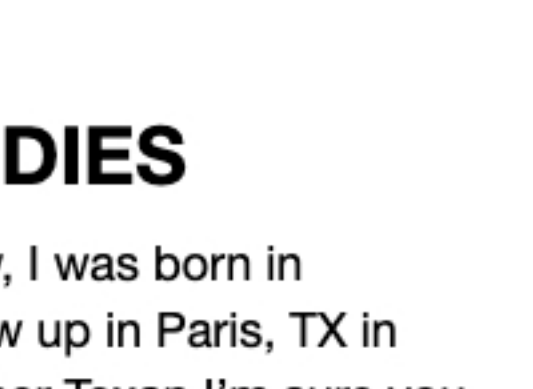
MISSOURI WEEKEND

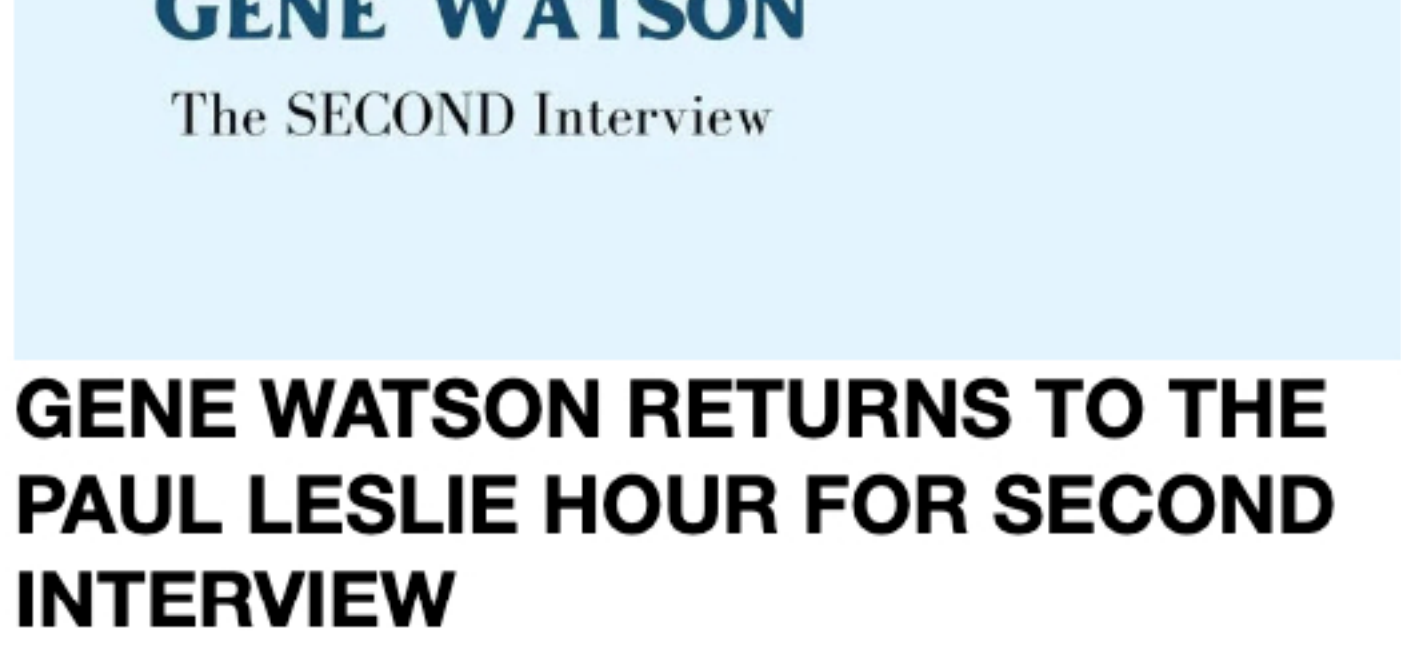

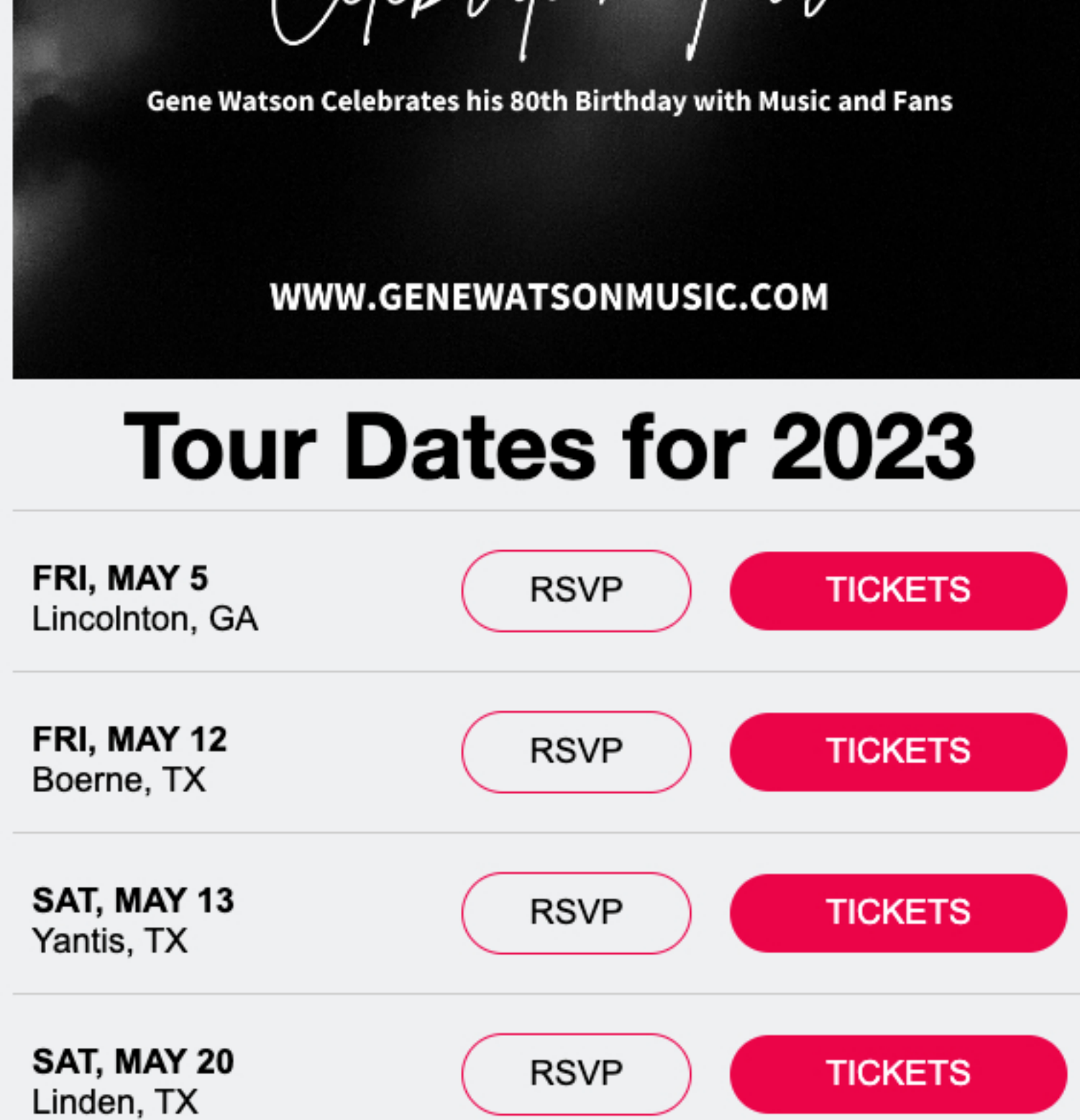

MUSIC IS GOOD FOR YOU!

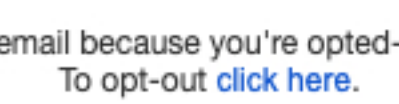
